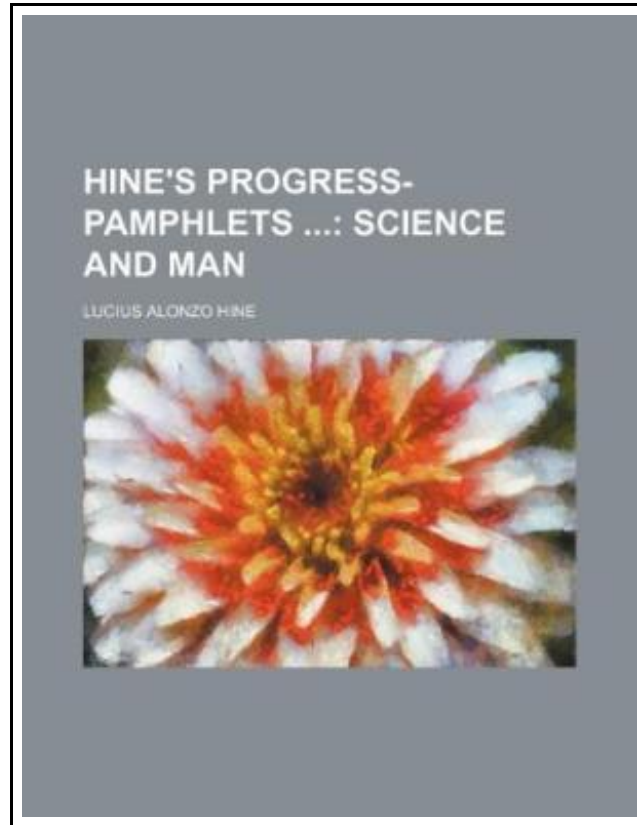

This is mentioned lest the enemies of Education free of cost may cite the increase of crime while Education is advancing, as evidence that it does not prevent crime. It will be seen that the causes given for this increase are amply adequate to account for it, leaving no excuse for skepticism. Another cause was the increase of Intemperance, consequent upon the same military excitement, and the flagging of Temperance effort. A third cause-has been the very large increase of immigration, which has thrown among us multitudes of foreign poor, many of whom have speedily found their way into crime for the relief of the most urgent necessities, for which our society does not provide. The immigration to New York has been as follows: 1846,115,230; 1847, 166,110; 1849, 191,909; 1850, 212,796; 1851,289,601. This wonderful increase goes far to account for the increase of crime from poverty. For the year ending June 1st, 1849, there were committed to the County Prison, of Monroe, New York, 769, of whom 409 were foreigners. Of the 902 inmates of the Alms House on Blackwelfs Island, in 1851, 760 were foreigners, and 142 natives. Of the 895 convicts in the Penitentiary at that time, 650 were foreigners, and 285 natives.
